

RULES AND INFORMATION

1. Exhibits and plant donations should be brought to the Hall between 11.30am and 1pm on Sunday 30th August.
2. No entry fee for exhibits.
3. For each exhibit please use a sealed envelope with your name enclosed. State 'inside' or 'outside' on all veg and fruit.
4. On the outside of the envelope write the class and category. Please state if exhibit was grown indoors.
5. Primary bairns - write the bairn's age on the envelope.
6. Secondary age - write "secondary" on the envelope.
7. Pot plants should have been in the possession of their owner for at least two months.
